

APPALACHIAN HORSE SHOW ASSOCIATION, INC. HIGH POINTS AWARDS 2009 SHOW SEASON CLASSES

Points will count at any Appalachian Horse Show Assoc. sanctioned show, as long as the class name is in compliance with Appalachian Horse Show Assoc. regardless of the prefix. (Examples are: BRHF - URHOEA - etc.)

NOTE: Both Owner and Exhibitor must be Members in order to receive points.

DIVISION 1: AMERICAN SADDLEBRED

- Class 1: ASB 5-Gaited (Amateur and Open classes)
- Class 2: ASB 3-Gaited (Amateur and Open classes)
- Class 3: ASB 3-Gaited Park Full Mane and Tail
- Class 4: ASB Open Park Pleasure (Note: Horses showing in this division may not cross enter into the Park or Show Pleasure division at the same show. Horses may wear tail sets in preparation for the show, but tied, gingered, and braced tails are prohibited. Horses may be shown by a professional, amateur, or juvenile.)
- Class 5: ASB Show Pleasure (Note: ASB Adult Show Pleasure and ASB Show Pleasure Amateur Owned and Trained will also count for points. Class is for horses with pads.)
- Class 6: ASB 5-Gaited Show Pleasure (Note: ASB 5-Gaited Show Pleasure – Amateur Trained or junior exhibitor will also count for points)
- Class 7: ASB English Country Pleasure (Note: ASB Adult English Pleasure, Adult Country Pleasure, ASB Country Pleasure Amateur Owned and Trained, and ASB Natural Country Pleasure will also count for points. Horses must be flat shod.)
- Class 8: ASB Juvenile English Country Pleasure (Note: ASB Juvenile English Pleasure, Juvenile Country Pleasure, ASB Country Pleasure Amateur Owned and Trained, and ASB Natural Country Pleasure will also count for points. Horses must be flat shod.)
- Class 9: ASB Western Country Pleasure (Note: Saddle and Bridle Shatner Western Country Pleasure will also count for points. Class is for flat shod horses.)
- Class 10: ASB Open Racking (Note: Horses showing in the ASB Racking Division may not cross enter into any other ASB class at the same show.)
- Class 11: ASB Style Racking (Note: Horses showing in the ASB Racking Division may not cross enter into any other division at the same show.)
- Class 12: Pleasure Ponies (Exhibitors 17 years and under)
- Class 13: Saddle Seat Equitation (Exhibitors 17 years and under) (Note: Pleasure Equitation will also count for points.)

DIVISION 2: NON-SADDLEBRED RACKING HORSE DIVISION

(Prefixes and "with action device" will also count for points.)

Pleasure Classes (Amateur only classes):

- Class 14: Trail Pleasure Racking (English or Western) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
- Class 15: Ladies Trail Pleasure Racking (English or Western) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
- Class 16: Men's Trail Pleasure Racking (English or Western) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
- Class 17: Juvenile Trail Pleasure Racking (English or Western) **keg shoe-3/8' x 3/4'**
- Class 18: Racking Country Pleasure (English or Western Flat Shod)
- Class 19: Ladies Racking Country Pleasure (English or Western, Flat Shod)
- Class 20: Men's Racking Country Pleasure (English or Western, Flat Shod)
- Class 21: Juvenile Racking Country Pleasure (English or Western, Flat Shod)
- Class 22: Spotted Country Pleasure (English or Western attire)
- Class 23: Country Show Pleasure (English or Western)
- Class 24: Men's Country Saddle (English or Western) (3 gaits) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
- Class 25: Ladies Country Saddle (English or Western) (3 gaits) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
- Class 26: Open Ambling Country Pleasure (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)
- Class 27: Open Keg Shod Pleasure (2 gaits)
- Class 28: Men's Ambling Country Pleasure (Amateur Exhibitor 18 years and over) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)*
- Class 29: Ladies Ambling Country Pleasure (Amateur Exhibitor 18 years and over) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)*
- Class 30: Spotted Ambling Country Pleasure (Amateur Exhibitor 18 years and over) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)
- Class 31: Juvenile Ambling Country Pleasure (Exhibitors 17 years and under) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)

Performance Classes:

- Class 32: Speed Racking (English attire)
- Class 33: Flat Shod Racking
- Class 34: Ladies Racking (English attire)
- Class 35: Amateur Owned and Trained Racking (English attire)
- Class 36: Men's Racking (English attire)
- Class 37: Style Racking (English attire) Note: Style Racking Flat Shod will also count for points
- Class 38: Open Racking (English attire)
- Class 39: Juvenile Racking, Non-Saddlebred (English attire)

Note: Horses may be nominated in the Performance classes or the Pleasure classes but not both.

Note: *If a show does not offer a Juvenile Ambling Country Pleasure class, Juveniles may exhibit in Ladies or Men's Ambling Country Pleasure class at that show. Points will count for Juvenile Ambling Country Pleasure nominations.

DIVISION 3: TENNESSEE WALKING HORSE DIVISION

Halter:

Class 40: Yearling Halter - Yearling Fillies and Yearling Colts shall also be counted for points.

Pleasure Classes:

- Class 41: Trail Pleasure Walking Specialty - (**keg shoe - 3/8 x 3/4**) (no canter) (English or Western) **Amateur** rider, AO&T Trail Pleasure classes shall also be counted.
- Class 42: Country Pleasure Walking/**KEG SHOE- (keg shoe)** (specialty - no canter) (English or Western) **Amateur** rider includes Plantation Country Pleasure classes.)
- Class 43: Plantation Pleasure Lite Shod Specialty (no canter) (lite 3/8 x 3/4 shoe) English tack and attire. Includes Amateur and Open classes.
- Class 44: Plantation Pleasure Lite Shod Specialty Western (no canter) (lite 3/8" x 3/4" shoe) Western tack and attire. Includes Amateur and Open classes.
- Class 45: Plantation Pleasure Specialty (no canter) – **No Bands.** 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Includes Amateur and Open classes. *
- Class 46: Western Plantation Pleasure Specialty (no canter) – **No Bands.** 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Includes Amateur and Open classes. *
- Class 47: Park Pleasure Specialty (no canter) 1 1/2" x 1/2:" shoe. Bands allowed. Includes Amateur and Open classes.*
- Class 48: Western Park Pleasure Specialty (no canter) 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Bands allowed. Includes Amateur and Open classes.*

*Horses may not be shown in both Plantation Pleasure and Park Pleasure at the same show. Horses without bands may show in Park Pleasure for points if Plantation Pleasure is not offered.

Performance Classes:

- Class 49: Performance Pleasure (Note: Walking Performance Pleasure, Performance Pleasure Specialty and Limited Performance Classes, Amateur and Open will be counted. Shoe not to exceed 1 1/2 "x 1/2" with a flat pad or wedge not to exceed 1" at the heel. Bands are optional. Approved action device.
- Class 50: Amateur Walking Specialty (no canter)
- Class 51: Amateur Owned and Trained Specialty (no canter) - Horses must be ridden by the owner or a family member. No professional training for 90 days.
- Class 52: Show Pleasure Walking Specialty (no canter) - Includes Amateur and Open classes.
- Class 53: Ladies Walking Specialty (no canter) - Includes Amateur and Open classes.
- Class 54: Juvenile Walking Specialty (no canter) - Exhibitors 17 years and under.

Spotted Saddle Horse:

Class 55: Spotted Saddle Horse Lite Shod Specialty – Lite Shod shoe 3/8 x 3/4 - 2 gaits, Western tack and attire.

DIVISION 4: ARABIAN HORSE DIVISION

Arabian Performance:

- Class 56: Arabian Western Pleasure
- Class 57: Amateur Arabian Western Pleasure
- Class 58: Arabian English Pleasure
- Class 59: Arabian Hunter Pleasure
- Class 60: Arabian Native Costume Class

Arabian Halter:

- Class 61: Open Arabian Halter

DIVISION 5: JUVENILE DIVISION

- Class 62: Best Groomed Pony (Exhibitor 17 years and under, any breed)
- Class 63: Best Groomed Horse (Exhibitor 17 years and under, any breed)
- Class 64: Juvenile Halter (Exhibitor 18 years and under)
- Class 65: Juvenile Beginner – English (Exhibitor 17 years and under) (Walk and Trot or Ambling Gait, no canter) (No cross entry of the rider in any performance class)
- Class 66: Juvenile Beginner - Western (Exhibitor 17 years and under) (Walk and Jog or Ambling Gait, no canter) (No cross entry of the rider in any performance class)
- Class 67: Best Junior Rider (Exhibitor 17 years and under, any breed) (Walk and Gait of Choice) (English or Western)
- Class 68: Juvenile Go As You Please (Exhibitor 17 years and under, any breed) (Walk and Gait of Choice) (English or Western)
- Class 69: Juvenile Costume Class (Exhibitor 17 years and under)

- Class 71: Youth Barrel Race (Exhibitor 12 years and under) Points will count for Youth if only barrels for 18 and under is offered.
- Class 72: Open Barrel Race
- Class 73: Juvenile Speed Race (Exhibitor 13-18 years)
- Class 74: Open Speed Race
- Class 75: Juvenile Poles (Exhibitor 13-18 years)
- Class 76: Open Poles

Western Division: Stock type, non gaited horses only

Western Halter:

- Class 82: 2-3 year olds - (Stock type, non gaited horses)
- Class 83: Aged 4 year and older - (Stock type, non gaited horses)Classes that divide Stallions & Geldings & Mares eligible
- Class 84: Open Western Halter – (Stock type, non gaited horses)

Performance: Stock type, non gaited horse only

- Class 85: Open Western Pleasure - (Non gaited, Stock type horses only)
- Class 86: Men's Western Pleasure (Exhibitors 19 years and over)
- Class 87: Ladies Western Pleasure (Exhibitors 19 years and over)
- Class 88: Western Pleasure Walk/Jog
- Class 89: Juvenile Western Pleasure Walk/Jog/Lope (18 years and under)
- Class 90: Hunter Under Saddle (walk/trot)
- Class 91: Hunter Under Saddle (walk, trot, canter)

Class 101: Open Costume - All Breeds

Class 102: Open Draft Horse at Halter

Class 103: Open Draft Horse to Cart (2 or 4 wheel cart)

Class 104: Open Mule Racing

Class 105: Open Go As You Please - All Breeds

Class 106: Open Hunter Under Saddle - All Breeds, (Walk, Trot, Canter), (At breed show, Breed Assoc. rules are followed)

Class 107: Equitation Over Fences/Rails - Any Breed, (At breed shows, Breed Assoc. rules are followed)

Class 108: Most Colorful(Horse) at Halter - Any Breed (At breed shows, Breed Assoc. rules are followed)
