HIGH POINTS AWARDS 2010 SHOW SEASON CLASSES

Points will count at any Appalachian Horse Show Assoc. sanctioned show, as long as the class name is compliant with Appalachian Horse Show Assoc. regardless of the prefix. (Examples are: BRHF - URHOEA - etc.)

NOTE: Points are awarded to nominated horse. Both Owner and Exhibitor must be AHSA Members in order to receive points. See regulations/rules for specific guidelines on classes that both horse and rider are judged and cross entry limitations. All memberships and nominations must be AHSA board approved.

DIVISION 1: AMERICAN SADDLEBRED CLASSES

1. **ASB 5-Gaited** (Amateur and Open classes)
2. **ASB 3-Gaited** (Amateur and Open classes)
3. **ASB Open Park Pleasure** (Note: Horses showing in this division may not cross enter into the Park or Show Pleasure division at the same show. Horses may wear tail sets in preparation for the show, but tied, gingered, and braced tails are prohibited. Horses may be shown by a professional, amateur, or juvenile.)
4. **ASB Show Pleasure** (Note: ASB Adult Show Pleasure and ASB Show Pleasure Amateur Owned and Trained will also count for points. Class is for horses with pads.)
5. **ASB 5-Gaited Show Pleasure** (Note: ASB 5-Gaited Show Pleasure – Amateur Trained or junior exhibitor will also count for points)
6. **ASB English Country Pleasure** (Note: ASB Adult English Pleasure, Adult Country Pleasure, ASB Country Pleasure Amateur Owned and Trained, and ASB Natural Country Pleasure will also count for points. Horses must be flat shod.)
7. **ASB Juvenile English Country Pleasure** (Note: ASB Juvenile English Pleasure, Juvenile Country Pleasure, ASB Country Pleasure Amateur Owned and Trained, and ASB Natural Country Pleasure will also count for points. Horses must be flat shod.)
8. **ASB Western Country Pleasure** (Note: Saddle and Bridle Shatner Western Country Pleasure will also count for points. Class is for flat shod horses.)
9. **ASB Open Racking** (Note: Horses showing in the ASB Racking Division may not cross enter into any other ASB class at the same show.)
10. **ASB Style Racking** (Note: Horses showing in the ASB Racking Division may not cross enter into any other division at the same show.)
11. **ASB English Equitation**
12. **Pleasure Ponies** (Exhibitors 17 years and under)
13. **Saddle Seat Equitation** (Exhibitors 17 years and under) (Note: Pleasure Equitation will also count for points.)
14. **Road Pony**
15. **Amateur Roadster Pony**
16. **Open Roadster Pony**
17. **Open Roadster Horse to Bike**
18. **Roadster Horse Under Saddle**

DIVISION 2: NON-SADDLEBRED RACKING HORSE DIVISION CLASSES

(Prefixes and "with action device" will also count for points.)

29. **Men's Country Saddle** (English or Western) (3 gaits) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
30. **Ladies Country Saddle** (English or Western) (3 gaits) **keg shoe- 3/8' x 3/4'**
31. **Open Ambling Country Pleasure** (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)
32. **Open Keg Shod Pleasure** (2 gaits)
33. **Men's Ambling Country Pleasure** (Amateur Exhibitor 18 years and over) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)*
34. **Ladies Ambling Country Pleasure** (Amateur Exhibitor 18 years and over) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)*
35. **Spotted Ambling Country Pleasure** (Amateur Exhibitor 18 years and over) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)
36. **Juvenile Ambling Country Pleasure** (Exhibitors 18 years and under) (All breeds, flat shod, no canter, 2 gaits)

Performance Classes:

37. **Speed Racking** (English attire)
38. **Flat Shod Racking**
39. **Ladies Racking** (English attire)
40. **Amateur Owned and Trained Racking** (English attire)
41. **Men's Racking** (English attire)
42. **Style Racking** (English attire) Note: Style Racking Flat Shod will also count for points

Note: Horses may be nominated in the Performance classes or the Pleasure classes but not both.

Note: *If a show does not offer a Juvenile Ambling Country Pleasure class, Juveniles may exhibit in Ladies or Men's Ambling Country Pleasure class at that show. Points will count for Juvenile Ambling Country Pleasure nominations.*

DIVISION 3: TENNESSEE WALKING HORSE DIVISION CLASSES

Halter:

45. **Yearling Halter** - Yearling Fillies and Yearling Colts shall also be counted for points.

Pleasure Classes:

46. **Trail Pleasure Walking Specialty - (keg shoe - 3/8 x 3/4)** (no canter) (English or Western) Amateur rider, AO&T Trail Pleasure classes shall also be counted.
47. **Country Pleasure Walking- (keg shoe)** (specialty - no canter) (English or Western) Amateur rider includes Plantation Country Pleasure classes.)
48. **Plantation Pleasure Lite Shod Specialty** (no canter) (lite 3/8 x 3/4 shoe) English tack and attire. Includes Amateur and Open classes.
49. **Plantation Pleasure Lite Shod Specialty Western** (no canter) (lite 3/8" x 3/4" shoe) Western tack and attire. Includes Amateur and Open classes.
50. **Plantation Pleasure Specialty** (no canter) – **No Bands.** 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Includes Amateur and Open classes. *
51. **Western Plantation Pleasure Specialty** (no canter) – **No Bands.** 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Includes Amateur and Open classes. *
52. **Park Pleasure Specialty** (no canter) 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Bands allowed. Includes Amateur and Open classes.*
53. **Western Park Pleasure Specialty** (no canter) 1 1/2" x 1/2" shoe. Bands allowed. Includes Amateur and Open classes.*
54. **Adult Pony:** Ponies 15.2 hands and under.

*Horses may not be shown in both Plantation Pleasure and Park Pleasure at the same show. Horses without bands may show in Park Pleasure for points if Plantation Pleasure is not offered.

Performance Classes:

55. **Performance Pleasure** (Note: Walking Performance Pleasure, Performance Pleasure Specialty and Limited Performance Classes, Amateur and Open will be counted. Shoe not to exceed 1 1/2 "x 1/2" with a flat pad or wedge not to exceed 1" at the heel. Bands are optional. Approved action device.
56. **Amateur Walking Specialty** (no canter)
57. **Amateur Owned and Trained Specialty** (no canter) - Horses must be ridden by the owner or a family member. No professional training for 90 days.
58. **Show Pleasure Walking Specialty** (no canter) - Includes Amateur and Open classes.
59. **Ladies Walking Specialty** (no canter) - Includes Amateur and Open classes.
60. **Juvenile Walking Specialty** (no canter) - Exhibitors 17 years and under.

Spotted Saddle Horse:

61. Class: Spotted Saddle Horse Lite Shod Specialty – Lite Shod shoe 3/8 x 3/4 - 2 gaits, Western tack and attire.

DIVISION 4: ARABIAN HORSE DIVISION CLASSES

Arabian Performance:

62. **Liberty Class**-USEF rules apply
63. **Arabian Western Pleasure**
64. **Arabian English Pleasure(No Hunt Seat)** Pads and toes not to exceed regulation length limits of 5 ins.

74. **Juvenile Beginner - Western** (Exhibitor 18 years and under) (Walk and Jog or Ambling Gait, no canter) (**No cross entry of the rider in any performance class**)
75. **Best Junior Rider** (Exhibitor 18 years and under, any breed) (Walk and Gait of Choice) (English or Western)
76. **Juvenile Go As You Please** (Exhibitor 18 years and under, any breed) (Walk and Gait of Choice) (English or Western)
77. **Juvenile Costume Class** (Exhibitor 18 years and under)
78. **Juvenile Showmanship** - Western in Halter, English in Bridle – (18 and under) All Breeds (1 of 6 AHSA/AQHA patterns will be selected and post at start of show by Judge or Show Manager). At breed shows, Breed Assoc. rules are followed.
79. **Leadline-12 and under, Horse must be saddled and on lead with adult 18 or older in control of horse. Show manager/Entry Manager can sign point tally list for rider to verify participation**

DIVISION 6: GYMKHANA DIVISION / WESTERN DIVISION CLASSES

Gymkhana Timed Events - Any Breed at Open Shows-Rules of National/International Associations Affiliations will be followed (including but not limited to AQHA, USEF, NBRA, IBRA, NRCHA, NRHA, NRCHA, etc.)

Breed Shows - breed rules and entry regulations are used (examples: AQHA, APHA, NFAQHA, AHA, ApHA. etc)

Gymkhana Division:

80. **Juvenile Barrel Race** (Exhibitor 13-18 years)
81. **Youth Barrel Race** (Exhibitor 12 years and under) Points will count for Youth if only barrels for 18 and under is offered.
82. **Ladies' Barrel Race**

WESTERN DIVISION:

Stock type, non saddlebred, non gaited horses only shown in the Western Division

Western Halter:

96. **Weanlings/Yearlings**-(All exhibitors in class must show Stock type non gaited non saddlebred horses)
97. **2-3 year olds** - (, All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non gaited non saddlebred horses)
98. **Aged 4 year & older Mares** - (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)
99. **Aged 4 year & older Geldings & Stallions**-(All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, on saddlebred non gaited horses)
100. **Championship Western Halter** – (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)

Performance Classes:

All horses exhibited in class must Be-Stock type, non saddlebred, non gaited horse only

101. **Championship/Open Western Pleasure** – walk, jog, lope (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)
102. **Juvenile Western Pleasure**-12yr and over- Walk, jog, lope (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)
103. **Men's Western Pleasure**(All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)(Exhibitors 19 years and over)
104. **Ladies Western Pleasure** (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses) (Exhibitors 19 years and over)

- 105. **Beginners Adult Walk/Jog-Ladies Western Pleasure** (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)(Exhibitors 19 years and over) **no cross entries**
- 106. **Western Adult Walk/Jog**(All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)Cross entries allowed to any class.
- 107. **Beginner Western Juvenile Walk/Jog** (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses) **no cross entries**(19 years and under)cross entries allowed to any class
- 108. **Western Juvenile Walk/Jog** (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses) **no cross entries**(19 years and under)
- 109. **Beginner/Green Rider Hunter Under Saddle**(walk/trot) (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses) **no cross entries**
- 110. **Hunter Under Saddle** (walk/trot) (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses) cross entries allowed to any class
- 111. **Hunter Under Saddle** (walk, trot, canter) (All exhibitors in class must show Stock type, non saddlebred non gaited horses)

- 121. **Adult Showmanship** – Western in Halter, English in Bridle - All Breeds (1 of 6 AHSA/AQHA patterns will be selected and post at start of show by Judge or Show Manager). At breed shows, Breed Assoc. rules are followed.
- 122. **Open Draft Horse at Halter**-All exhibitors in class must be showing Draft Horse
- 123. **Open Draft Horse to Cart** (2 or 4 wheel cart) All exhibitors in class must be showing Draft Horse(s)
- 124. **Open Mule Racing**(All exhibitors in class must be riding mule)
- 125. **Open Go As You Please** - All Breeds, any age
- 126. **Open Hunter Under Saddle** - All Breeds Any age, (Walk, Trot, Canter), (At breed show, Breed Assoc. rules are followed)
- 127. **Most Colorful(Horse) at Halter** - Any Breed, Any age
- 128. **Open Western Walk/Jog**- Western Attire and tack required, All Breed, Any age (**cross entries allowed**)
- 129. **Modeling Class**-Horses shown at halter or bridle all breeds and any age. Horses judged on conformation appropriate for breed.
- 130. **Jack Benny/Lucille Ball Class**: Riders must be over 39, open to all breeds. Judge will determine gaits...
- 131. **Hunter Hack**- Open to all riders and breeds. Walk, trot and canter. Horses required to jump 2 fences 18"-23
