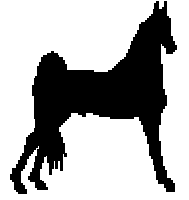

Entry fees: \$10 – Classes 2 – 8, 10 – 28 --- Premium \$20, \$10, \$5, R, R
\$15 – Classes 29 - 34 --- Premium \$30, \$20, \$10, R, R
No Entry Fee for Classes 1 & 9 – Ribbons awarded to all participants



- Stalls - \$5 each (pay at Secretary's booth when entering, no reservations required)
- Negative Coggins test required on all horses entering the grounds within the last 12 months.
- All dogs must be on leash.
- Judge's decision is final.
- In classes that have less than 3 entries, 2nd place money will be awarded.
- Classes will be added if 2 or more entries are entered for the class.
- This is a fun show – no specific dress code is required. Exception: long sleeves are required in all game classes.
- Speed Events: All horses must start and stop inside of the ring gate.
- The Bland County Fair, Incorporated and the County of Bland will in no way be responsible for any loss or accident to person, horse, or equipment while attending or exhibiting in the show.
- No persons allowed in the ring at the time of judging except ring officials and attendants when necessary.
