- Musical Freestyle or upper level tests by request

Entry fees: \$15 first test, \$10 each additional test (*same horse/rider combo*)
\$10 Sport Horse classes (SHUS, SHEq, SHIH, SHShowmanship)

Awards: First place prize, ribbons to 6 places; points for End of Year Awards only for MEDA members

Stabling & Warm-up: Stabling available at \$20 (Friday 4 pm thru end of show), includes bedding. **Stalls must be cleaned before departure.** Warm-up arena will be open for schooling from 4:00 – 7:30 pm Friday evening and all day Saturday. Warm-up in main arena from 8:00 – 8:30 am Saturday only. **FACILITY MUST BE VACATED BY 8 PM Friday evening (VI personnel checks on horses during the night).**
