~ Juveniles will not be allowed to show a stallion in any juvenile class.

~ Stalls are available for \$10.00 per stall and will be assigned at the secretary's booth or you may reserve a stall in advance by calling Angie Anderson, 276-356-8700.

~The Washington County Fair Association, the Washington Fairgrounds, any of their volunteers or any of the class sponsors will not be held liable or responsible for any injury to any person, or animal, or for any damage to or loss of personal property on the show grounds and horses are to be exhibited at the risk of the owner or exhibitor.
